Radios in use

- Three types of radios
 - Commercial VHF
 - Longer range
 - Commercial UHF
 - Two brands: Kenwood, Motorola
 - Different channel numbers!
 - PMR446 446 MHz FM
 - Compact size
- Open netwoks, possibility of interception or interference
- Main frequency/channel, backup frequency
 - Move to backup only if instructed so!
 - WhatsApp is used if the radios fail

Scoring	Scoring personnel + RO/scorekeeper in one stage	PMR446	

Networks ...

- Stages can only communicate to same area, to Area CRO and to QM for that area
 - Calls to the RM, PF etc must go via Area CRO
 - Area CROs have two radios
 - Generally, stages need not listen for traffic for them
 - We know where you are
 - However listening does not hurt
- Only heads of the office and QMs are in General network
 - Office network is organised by CSO
 - Area QMs are on the area networks

Protocol on the radio

- Only one person can talk at one time
- Remember to wait one second after pressing the PTT
 - Give receiver time to wake up
 - Otherwise, call to "RANGE MASTER" goes out as "MASTER"
- Describe issue, and what is needed, in plain language (no codes)
 - SCORING ISSUE AT STAGE 15, PLEASE COME
 - DQ AT STAGE 16, PLEASE COME
 - POPPER CHALLENGE AT STAGE 17, NEED CALIBRATION
 - NEED 2 TARGET STICKS AND 5 IPSC TARGETS AT STAGE 13
- Open network
 - So no detailed personal information
 - Name or competitor number is ok if necessary

Area 3 CRO wants to contact RM – first say who you want to contact and then who you are

RANGE MASTER ON MY WAY TO 16. OUT.

Business is finished and channel is now available

Scoring

- On some stages, the scoring detachment waits in a safe place while competitor is shooting, and goes out when range is clear
- Imperative that
 - LAMR is not given before scoring detachment is safe
 - RIC is not given before gun and competitor are safe
- Radio with RO or scorekeeper and with scoring detachment
 - Separate frequency (not on area network nor other scoring networks)
- Press PTT while giving relevant range commands
 - LAMR
 - RIC

Scoring...

- If there is no radio contact, stay in a safe state until communication is restored
 - Backup comms: Mobile phone

Scoring, start

Scoring detachment is in a safe place and shooting can commence

SCORE 29 IS SAFE

Remember to press PTT, wait 1 second, then start talking (to give receiver time to wake up)

RO/scorekeeper answers by issuing LAMR to a shooter while pressing PTT

LOAD AND MAKE READY

Scoring detachment goes to a safe place and verifies this

SCORE 29 IS SAFE

Emergencies

- Severe injury or illness
 - Gunshot wound
 - Heart attack
 - Anything else which is life-threatening
- Call emergency number 112 right away (better to have a Finn call)
- After that, inform Area CRO
 - CRO informs RM, MD & First Aid
 - Immediate cease-fire over whole range until police/emergency services gives clearance to commence firing (RM).
 - Guides to all intersections (MD).


